

**Community Service Events
CLUB Volunteer Form**

Background: Community Service Events is a core program of ASI that promotes student activism within the Sacramento community and promotes student involvement on campus. Currently, another ASI core program that has the same goals as Community Service Events is Safe Rides. Currently, there is a \$500 DOC eligibility increase when an organization volunteers for 6 nights with Safe Rides, but no such incentive exists with Community Service Events.

Currently if an organization is limited to day time activity, then they are unfairly shut out from the \$500 DOC increase due to the limited evening hours that Safe Rides have. Community Service Events allows for student organizations to have more options when it comes to fulfilling their required community service hours.

Action: After completion of the 150 approved ASI Community Service hours by an organization, the group's Dollars for Organizations and Clubs (DOC) eligibility will be increased from \$1,500 to \$2,000 in the fiscal year the community service is completed. Hours will only be counted for this program from approved volunteer sites from the ASI Community Service Events staff.

The fall semester ASI Community Service Events and Caesar Chavez Community Service Day will be included in the 150 hours. When an organization has completed 150 verified volunteer hours, the Director of Community Service Events will notify the Chair of the DOC committee of the increased eligibility.
