i “This bill would authorize the California State University to establish and implement programs that address the housing needs of faculty or California State University employees who face challenges in securing affordable housing, as specified.

b. AB 2953 (Alvarez) University of California and California State

University: first generation students: outreach and admission

i “This bill would require the California State University, and would request the University of California, to develop and implement a 4-year accountability plan for outreach to, and admission of, first-generation students to the segment, as specified.

ii Discussion, supported unanimously.

c. AB 1841 (Weber) Student Safety: opioid overdose reversal medications: student housing facilities

- iii. “This bill would require the governing board of each community college district and the Trustees of the California State University to...notify, by sending an email at the beginning of each academic semester or term, students of the presence and location of fentanyl test strips and opioid overdose reversal medication, and to distribute, at the beginning of each academic semester or term, 2 doses of federally approved opioid overdose reversal medication obtained through the Naloxone Distribution Project to residential advisers who work in a university- or college-affiliated student housing facility, and to house managers who work in a university- or college- affiliated fraternity or sorority facility that provides housing to its student members.
 - a. Supported by the majority in discussion.

- d. AB 2586 (Alvarez) Public postsecondary education: student employment
