Campaigning before the permitted time:

The ASI code, on page 14, prohibits the use: "Candidates will only be posted as eligible to campaign when the when the work shop is completed and all the other requirements are met. No Campaigning of any kind will be permitted prior to posting of eligibility, the onset of official campaign period." On 22nd march at 12:35AM I took a screenshot of a campaign Instagram account. As her following was growing, she started following people and her Bio was "Vote Henna Batool for Director of Engineering and Computer Science" before campaigning was allowed. This is a clear violation of election code which provided her with extra time to start campaigning on a social media platform.
