A. Call Meeting to Order & Review October Minutes

 - Ciobha focuses on the developmental disabilities for children

B. Current Center Updates

1. Vacancy Full-Time Position – Administrative Assistant II/III

• There are a few applicants that have been looked at

2. Enrollment/Funding -

- CCAMPIS has a surplus of funds for student parents (\$1000 per child once a month, \$500 for sibling)
- Suspension of a child for the first time in 10 years
- PAC members discussed The Children's Center 2024/2025 calendar in-service and closure dates
 - Possible mixed ages in classrooms due to limited staff availability following finals week
 - PAC members recommended to keep center open 2 days 12/16/24 and 12/17/24

3. Playground Conceptual Planning sessions concluded

- Sessions ended Friday 11/3
- It will be a drastic and positive change not only for the children but for the adults/staff
- Removing most of the hard metal on the playgrounds to create more of an outdoor classroom
- Adding 1 mixed age space (adults, infants, and children), a green house, and an outdoor meeting space

4. Cal-Fire Grant

• Sherry Velte has scheduled out dates to complete grant due 12/1/2023

5. Harvest Festival – October (10/31) –Lovely event

- Jazmyne Wright (chair) gave positive feedback about the activities that were provided for the children
