1. Vacancy Full-Time position

- There is an Associate Teacher/Fellowship vacancy

2. Enrollment/Funding/Events

- Sherry had put in a lot of hours to complete the Cal Fire Grant. It was submitted 3/1/24
- If grant is accepted, Sherry will know by July
- The Center had a four day contracting monitor review 2/20-2/23
 - The entire center was reviewed, the focus was on the La Casitas and Casas. There were no citations made, but there is room for improvement and action plans are being made
 - Sherry and Nancy are making corrections on the Parent Handbook
 - Administrative work received 100% compliance
 - Office staff has enforced parents to sign their full legal signature when signing in/out their child
 - The Center will be getting another visit from CMR and they will focus on CCTR from 3/18-3/22
 - The center is closed for child care Friday 3/22 for Staff in-Service day
 - Sherry will be presenting the finance and budget committee to the board 3/5 at 3pm
 - The center will be participating in a Mother's Day clothing drive starting the week of 3/25

3. Classrooms

- General and common illness are making their way through the center such as Hand, Foot, Mouth and bad colds with coughs, runny noses and vomiting
- We will create signs and send reminders about the center closure date on 3/22
- Head Teachers will need to follow through with student staffs and make sure they are consistent with children also.
