Position Summary: The Assistant Rowing Coach provides support to the assigned Rowing Coach or Coaches in collaboration with or independently. Instruct, motivate and educate athletes on the fundamentals of Olympic rowing. All duties are performed in collaboration with the Rowing Manager and other Rowing Coaches. The Assistant Rowing is responsible for the education, safety, and well-being of all athletes under their care. Assist Rowing Coaches in the operations and organization of rowing league races. Ensure equipment within the rowing program is maintained in collaboration with the Rowing Manager. Recommend replacement parts as needed. Develop and maintain relationships with students, athletes, parents and coaching staff. Provide support to Aquatic Center special events as required. Drive program vehicle for classes, trips or activities as needed. Other duties may be assigned.
