Position Summary: The Rowing Coach provides supervision to athletes and students. The Aquatic Center has four head rowing coach positions, Head Varsity Men and Head Varsity Women, and Head Novice Men and Head Novice Women for Capital Crew. Teach, educate and positively motivate on the fundamentals of Olympic rowing. All duties are performed in collaboration with the Rowing Managers and other Rowing Coaches. Responsible for education, safety, and well-being of all athletes under their care. Assist Rowing Managers in the operations and organization of rowing league races. Ensure equipment maintenance in collaboration with Rowing Managers. Recommend replacement parts as needed. Develop and maintain relationships with athletes, parents and coaching staff. Provide support to Aquatic Center special events as required. This requires overtime. Drive program vehicle for classes, trips or activities as needed.
