PEAK ADVENTURES Expedition Youth Camp Counselor -Seasonal

Position Summary: Under the supervision of the Peak Adventures Programs Specialist, the Expedition Youth Camp Counselor is responsible for the daily operations of Expedition camp. They work as part of a two-counselor team and are responsible for the safety, instruction and participation of campers, ages 13 – 17 years old, in a week-long (Mon – Fri, overnight) outdoor backpacking camp.

Time Base: 40hrs/week plus overtime

ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Oversight of 6 – 10 campers per week.
- Attend mandatory trainings related to the position.
- Demonstrate proficiency in backpacking.
- Oversee group dynamics of the campers and managing group cohesion.
- Maintain camper behavior, discipline and enforce consequences.
- Oversee and make decisions about risk management in the field.
- Oversee water safety.
- Manage group travel in the backcountry.
- Lead & facilitate games.
- Communicate with parents regarding camper behavior.
- Clean-up and maintain camp equipment and supplies.
- Plan meals and purchase food (funded by Peak Adventures) for five days of camp for 8 – 12 people.
- Teach and practice Leave No Trace.
- Teach backcountry hygiene.
- Operation of a 12-passenger van.
- Run a pre-trip meeting.
- Take pictures throughout camp week.
- Check-in and check-out of campers on Monday and Friday.
- Other duties as assigned.

- Enjoy being with youth and be an educator as well as a role model
- Ability to effectively communicate with youth and adults
- Exceptional customer service skills
- Good analytical and problem-solving skills
- Ability to follow oral and written instructions
- Ability to speak publicly in front of youth and adults
- Ability to be flexible and adaptive
- Ability to work well with other staff and camp partners

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- CPR Certification (On-line certification not accepted)
- Wilderness First Aid (WFA) Certification

- Obtain a Class B Driver's License with a Passenger Endorsement prior to start of camps
- Meet ASI driving requirements
- Successfully pass a background check
- Ability to lift and move up to 60 pounds

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Experience working with youth
- Experience with backpacking including equipment (tents & stoves) and backcountry cooking
- Experience leading games & facilitating activities
- Water safety skills
- Class B Driver's License with a Passenger Endorsement
