This position works as part of a two-counselor team and is responsible for the safety, instruction and participation of campers, ages 8-11 years old in games, arts & crafts and other camp activities.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Oversight of 6 – 20 campers per week.
- Attend mandatory trainings related to the position.
- Oversee group dynamics of the campers and managing group cohesion.
- Maintain camper behavior, discipline and enforce consequences.
- Oversee and make decisions about risk management in the field.
- Lead & facilitate games, arts & crafts and other camp activities.
- Communicate with parents regarding camper behavior issues.
- Oversee camp snacks and practice good food handling.
- Take pictures throughout camp week.
- Clean-up and maintain camp room and supplies.
- Belay participants on some climbing elements at the Peak Adventures Challenge Center.
- Teach and practice Leave No Trace (LNT).
- Daily check-in and check-out of campers.
- Other duties as assigned.
